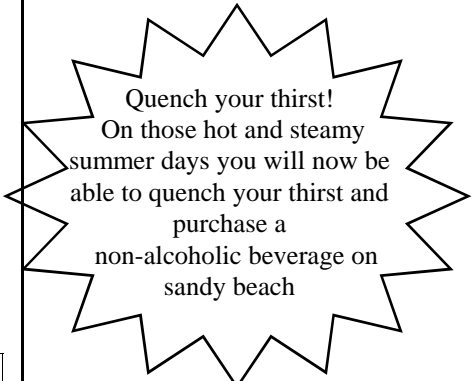

photo taken by Richard Perry at the Bring-a-Dish Dinner. Anyone who missed it can view the photo by clicking on the link from the club's website home page.

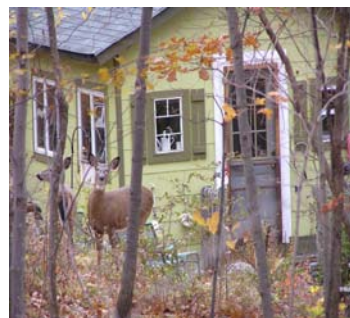
Wash the Day Off
